JUNIOR AND ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES

CLUB BY-LAW – ARTICLE X (Excerpts)

SECTION 1. Each applicant for membership into the Nimrod League of Holden, Inc. shall be presented to the investigating committee. Each application for membership must be accompanied with one year's dues according to ARTICLE XI, SECTION 1 and an application fee of \$40.00 for Associate Members. There is no application fee for Junior memberships. In the event of rejection of the candidate, all monies will be refunded. Upon receiving a favorable report from the investigating committee, the club shall take a "yea" or "nay" vote. A simple majority of those Senior Members voting is required for membership.

SECTION 4. Junior Member shall be from age 15 to 21. Junior members are allowed one guest to accompany them using club facilities. A Junior member may bring more than one guest by receiving permission from a member of the Club's Executive Board. Junior members have no House privileges, except at regular Club functions. Junior members have NO voting privileges. Junior members will automatically become Associate Members when they reach their 21st birthday.

SECTION 5. Associate Members must be a minimum of 21 years old. Associate Members have NO voting privileges. Associate Members have full Club and House privileges.

CLUB BY-LAW – ARTICLE XI (Excerpts)

SECTION 1. The yearly dues to The Nimrod League of Holden, Inc. shall be \$80.00 for both Senior and Associate Members and \$40.00 for Junior Members. Memberships run from January 1st to December 31st.

SECTION 2. The total membership of The Nimrod League of Holden, Inc. shall not exceed Three Hundred (300) Members. Senior Membership will be limited to Two Hundred (200) Members.

SECTION 5. A minimum of 8 hours of club related service is required of each member annually. Service may be assigned and approved by any club officer or committee chairman.

All new members are encouraged to familiarize themselves with ALL Club By-Laws.

Membership application process example	
Step 1.	Obtain references from two current Club Members
Step 2.	Complete and submit membership application with appropriate fees to a Club Officer or Secretary
Step 3.	Application is brought before the Executive Board investigating committee and voted upon to bring before the Club Membership. Executive Board meetings are held the last Tuesday of each month.
Step 4.	Senior Members at the next regularly scheduled Membership meeting will vote on application. Membership meetings are normally held the second Tuesday of each month.
Step 5.	Upon successful acceptance of your application, you will receive a key to the road gate, membership card, and car decal valid for the remainder of the membership year (Jan. 1 to Dec. 31)
